CLASS FEE - \$20 per go, no refunds for scratched classes

OFFICE FEE - \$20 (one time, per horse/rider)

JUDGE FEE - \$15 (one time, per horse/rider)

CLINIC FEE - \$100 (limited number of riders)

CLINIC AUDIT FEE - \$25

TRAIL SCHOOLING FEE - \$15 per go

POST ENTRY FEE - \$20 register after deadline – September 5, 2025

CHECKS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY September 5 to avoid fee

STALLS - \$30 per night, must pre-book online

SHAVINGS - \$15 bale **no outside shavings allowed**

HAUL IN - \$15 per day/ per horse

EARLY ARRIVALS - \$50 per day in addition to accommodations

RV SPOT - \$45 per night, must pre-book online

DRY CAMPING - \$10 per night, must pre-book online

NSF FEE - \$45 charge to any checks returned for NSF

Exhibitors and horses may begin
arriving Friday at 10 am. Unless
participating in the clinic and have prior
approval. Arrivals before 10 am will be
considered early.

THANK YOU for joining us at the **BUCKLE UP! RANCH HORSE SCHOOLING SERIES**. We are excited that you have selected to join us at the gorgeous Washington State Horse Park venue. Our vision for this event is to have fun and enjoy the weekend with our horses and friends while improving and testing our ranch riding skills! We have a little housekeeping to keep everyone on the same page and safe.

This schooling show has no national sanction. For guidance the show will follow AQHA ranch riding rules.

Friday Clinic will be taught by the judge for the weekend offering pointers for each class.

Ribbons are available from 1st to 6th place.

Buckles will be awarded to the exhibitor with the most points per division after all 3 events have been completed.

All ties shall be broken by number of first place wins or fewest penalties whichever applies

Show management reserves the right to make final decisions.

DIVISIONS

Rookie Amateur Division - Exhibitor has not earned more than 10 lifetime points or \$500 in any breed or national organization. And have not engaged in training or assisting training to horses that do not belong to them, judging horse shows or coaching other riders in the last 5 years.

Amateur Division – Exhibitors that have not engaged in training or assisting training to horses that do not belong to them, judging horse shows or coaching other riders in the last 5 years. Riders 19 years and older.

Youth Division – Exhibitors under the age of 18. Stallions are not allowed in youth classes.

Select Division – Exhibitors 50 and older.

Open Division - Exhibitors may show up to four horses per class.

Green Division - Horses and/or riders in the first year of showing that specific class.

Walk Trot Division - Any exhibitor who feels they are not ready for a class that includes loping. No crossover to loping classes.

Jr Horse – Horses that are 5 years old and younger

Sr Horse – Horses that are over 6 years old.

GENERAL RULES

Ownership – Riders do not have to own the horse they are showing.

Horse Age - No horses less than 3 years of age may be exhibited.

Holding the saddle horn with either hand is allowed.

Posting at the extended trot is acceptable.

Schooling equipment is not allowed.

Tack equipment follows AQHA ranching riding rules.

Proper attire is required. Helmets are allowed.

Practice safe arena etiquette, be aware of your surroundings and courteous to other riders.

When the water truck and or drag tractor enters the arena, please stop riding and exit the arena.

Lunging is not allowed in arenas, use designated lunging areas.

Please respect the WSHP ground rules - Obey all posted signs and announcements.

10 MPH Speed Limit for all vehicles.

Dogs must be always kept on leash.

No tying dogs or horses to trees, fences, barns or arenas.

Camp in designated areas only, inquire at the office if you have any questions.

Please control children and dogs so as not to spook horses and for everyone's safety.

Pick up after yourself and your horses and dogs.... Leave no mess behind.
